IB World School offering the IB-DP opportunity with special application for students with strong language and academic records. 2-year programme.

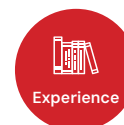

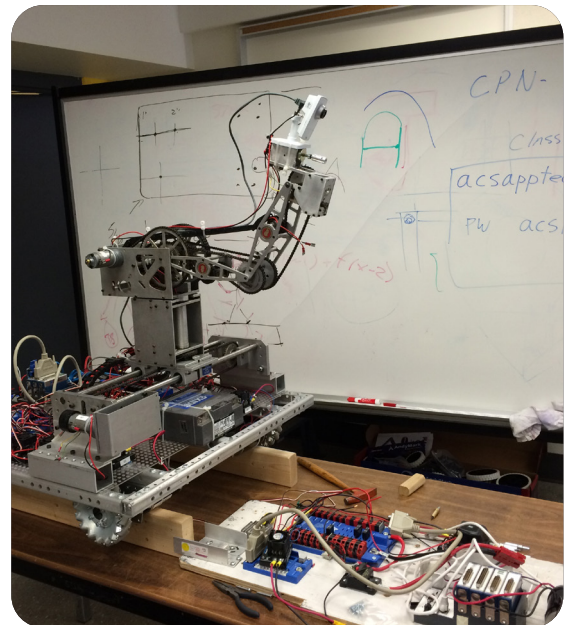
